- Coed pairs must perform a minimum of one tossed extended stunt and one, double twisting dismount from a single legged stunt. All-Girl group must perform a minimum of one double twisting dismount from a single legged stunt.
- Individual athletes may only compete ONCE in either the pairs or quad competition.

(ie. a top cannot be with both guad groups or on a guad group and a co-ed pair).

- Athletes are to perform in their team uniforms, not practice gear.
- Groups may enter who are not also competing in the team' portion of the Nationals. The entry fees are noted above.
- Stunt competition regulations follow the USASF Level 6 guidelines (International Division Entarnts follow L-5).
- Routines may not exceed 60 seconds in length.
- Co-ed pairs AND Quad Groups are to bring their own spotters (on to the floor)
- "International" Division Stunt pairs/groups must include one member under the age 17 eligibility line.

PCA reserves the right to possibly not offer this division to groups not entered in the team categories. Call first.

The following conditions apply to the PARTNER STUNT and QUAD competition only. The team event deadlines are different.

All paid partner stunt entries and forms must be received AT the PCA Office on or before Wednesday November 11, 2009.

LATE entries (received between and including November 12, 2009 and November 25, 2009) will have the following applied to them:

- 1. \$10.00 late fee is added to partner pairs. \$20.00 late fee for guad groups.
- 2. Entry into the competition MAY be denied if numbers are too high or the registration is late. Please apply early.

No entries will be accepted after Nov 25, 2009
